I. The character of a bold witness

- Bold, yet flawed
 - The life of Peter
- Will we let our flaws keep us from being a witness?

II. The competency of a bold witness

A bold witness ...

1. ... is filled by the Holy Spirit

- Jesus' encouragement to wait for the Holy Spirit before being witnesses
(Acts 1:4, 1:8)

2. ... begins where the people are

Acts 2:12-16

3. ... clearly communicates the truth and grace of Jesus Christ.

Acts 2:36 "Therefore let all Israel be assured of this: God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ."

Acts 2:37

4. ... guides a response to the truth and grace of Jesus Christ.

Acts 2:38-39

A, B, C

Admit – repent, turn from sin

Believe – trust Jesus Christ

Confess – publicly declare or receive Christ
