

## Pentecost: The Holy Spirit Poured Out

Acts 2:1-21 (Page 1692)

### I. The Holy Spirit is to be poured out on all people.

Acts 2:17-18 "In the last days, God says, 'I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams. Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days, and they will prophesy.'"

### II. When the Holy Spirit is poured out there is conviction and convection.

#### A. Conviction / Work in

Acts 2:37 "... cut to the heart..."

Acts 2:38 "Peter replied, 'Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.'"

- Quenching the Spirit

I Thessalonians 5:19 "Do not put out the Spirit's fire" (Quench the Spirit).

#### B. Convection / work out

- Convection – the act or process of conveying; transmission

Acts 2:38-39 "And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off – for all whom the Lord our God will call."

- The work-out follows the work-in.

Philippians 2:12-13 "Continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling, for it is God who works in you to will and to act according to his good purpose."
